<p><b>8. Southbank Sauvignon Blanc 2009, Marlborough, N Zealand</b> A superb quality dry wine with refined herbaceous tropical fruit flavours from one of the top producers in New Zealand. <p><b>9. Chablis 'La Pierelee' 2007, La Chablisienne, Burgundy</b> Crisply dry and unmistakably Chablis, but has good creamy fruit as well. The producer, La Chablisienne is one of the most conscientious winemakers in France and is a cooperative of some 250 growers whose grapes go through an annual tasting with only the best quality fruit being selected.</p>	<p><b>£29.65</b></p>

- 12. Paternina Banda Rosado Rose 2008, DOC Rioja, Spain** £4.95 £17.35  
A delicious, dry, fruity rose with a fine depth of flavour and body. Rioja rose is not commonly found in the UK, this wine should change things!
- 14. CYT Cabernet Blush 2009, Concha y Toro, Chile** £4.40 £15.50  
A medium dry pink with a hint of soft red fruit flavours.

## *Red Wines*

- 18. CYT Merlot 2009, Chile – Our House Selection** £4.40 £15.50  
Youthful, ripe fruit dominates with a hint of soft fruit tannins
- 19. Saddle Creek Shiraz/Cabernet 2009, South-East Australia** £4.95 £17.35  
A smoky combination of dark fruit flavours from sun-baked vineyards.
- 20. Trivento Malbec 2010, Argentina** £5.10 £17.50  
Dark almost smoky flavours from the foothills of the Andes, grown at high altitude this is Argentina's signature grape variety.
- 21. Campos de Luz Old Vines Garnacha 2009, Carinena, Spain** £17.95  
With an average age in excess of 30 years these old Garnacha vines produce a wine with a full, rounded flavour without being heavy on the palate.
- 22. Foot of Africa Pinotage 2009, Stellenbosch, South Africa** £18.85  
Ripe, sweet berry flavours backed up by a woody tar finish
- 23. Le Campuget Syrah/Grenache 2010, Vin de Pays du Gard, France** £18.95  
Attractive red fruit flavours in this soft red from Southern France. The grapes are from a vineyard owned by family producers based in the Rhone region.
- 24. 'Sogatia' Chianti 2008 DOCG, Tuscany** £19.95  
Great new-wave, fruit driven Chianti with the unmistakable 'edge' to the flavour. This is a soft, food-driven style of wine with hints of bitter cherry on the finish.
- 25. Paternina Banda Azul 2006, DOC Rioja, Spain** £21.00  
Spain's best selling Rioja. Developed, brambly, smoky fruit with the benefit of ageing in barrel which adds complexity to the structure and flavour.
